

Student Fee Transparency

Explanation of Fees

Application Fee: A one-time fee that accompanies the admissions application. The application fee covers costs associated with the processing of an admissions application.

Registration Fee: A fee assessed the first semester or instructional period of the program for new and re-enrolling students. The registration fee secures a student's enrollment in the program and covers costs associated with scheduling.

Graduation Fee: A one-time fee assessed during the final semester or instructional period to defray the cost of the graduation ceremony.

Exam/Certification Fee: A fee associated with the cost of taking an industry or licensing exam. In all programs and courses except for the Commercial Driver's License course, a student taking an industry or licensing exam or certification more than one time, for any reason, is responsible for any additional costs. Students taking the Commercial Driver's License course will have three (3) attempts to pass this certification, after which the cost of any additional attempt(s) will be the responsibility of the student.

Equipment and Operation Fee: The equipment and operation fee applies to programs that require the use of specialized equipment, machinery, vehicles, simulators, or operational training environments. This fee helps cover the costs associated with equipment use, maintenance, fuel, operational supplies, safety materials, and other resources necessary for hands-on training and skills development.

Lab Fee: This fee applies to programs that include a laboratory and/or clinical component. This fee helps cover the costs of materials, supplies, equipment, and consumable resources used by students as part of their required laboratory or clinical training activities.

Technology Fee: The technology fee supports student access to technology resources and digital learning tools used as part of the educational experience. This fee helps offset the costs associated with educational software, learning platforms, computer and network infrastructure, student technology services, and other digital assets that support instruction, communication, and student learning.

Student Support Services Fee: The student support services fee is assessed to provide services and resources that directly benefit students throughout their enrollment. These services may include student activities, guest speakers, library database access, student portal access, advising services, career development resources, portfolio preparation assistance, resume and interview preparation, professional photography services, and employment assistance activities.
